

New NSW Forensic Pathology and Coroner's Court at Lidcombe

The NSW Government is investing \$91.5 million in a new, state-of-the-art health and justice facility at Lidcombe.

The new facility will house NSW Health Pathology's forensic medicine services and the NSW Coroner's Court which are currently located at Glebe.

The new purpose-built facility will provide vital services for coronial cases and care and support that is responsive to community needs.

Planning approval

In April 2017, the State Significant Development Application for the new Forensic Pathology and Coroner's Court facility at Lidcombe was approved by the NSW Department of Planning and Environment.

Site preparation and demolition works on the existing buildings have commenced.

Main construction works are expected to commence in the next few months. Construction of the new facility is expected to be completed and the facility operational by 2019.

How will construction impact be managed?

Construction impact will be managed in accordance with environmental management plans to mitigate the impact of noise, vibration, dust and traffic.

How was my feedback considered?

We have listened to your feedback, and wherever possible considered it within our design.

Updates to the design include:

- A revised site access arrangement to Main Avenue, now providing left exit only and the previously proposed additional driveway has been removed.
- Improved vehicle circulation within the public carpark, which will minimise traffic exiting onto Main Avenue.
- Signage and wayfinding to minimise the impact of traffic on the local street network within Botanica Estate.
